## About the Department of Community Services

Community Services consists of four divisions, each with its own focus, all with the same goal—to provide quality programs and services to the residents of Charles County.

**Child care programs** were developed to help provide affordable, quality child care. The County Commissioners established a cooperative partnership with a private child care vendor, AlphaBEST Education, Inc.

The **Aging & Community Centers Division** serves as Charles County's Area Agency on Aging and advocates on behalf of older persons. The Division provides programming and planning of recreational activities at the Nanjemoy Community Center as well as through the four Senior Centers. Senior Center class and program listings can be found in the Latest SCOOP, a monthly senior citizen publication available online at [www.charlescounty.org/cs](http://www.charlescounty.org/cs) and at each of the four Senior Centers (as well as the Department of Community Services in Port Tobacco).

The **Housing & Community Development Division** administers a variety of housing programs designed to assist low- and moderate-income persons, including the elderly and handicapped.

The **Recreation Division** provides activities and indoor sports programs to promote health, wellness, and quality of life. It operates the Recreation Centers, Indoor Community Pools, and eight school-based Community Centers.

The **Transportation Division** manages VanGO, which provides general public transit, and limited specialized services.



## Aquatics Classes

### High School Swim Clinic



This program is designed to give high school students an opportunity to prepare for the upcoming swimming season. This program will be developed for both returning and those new to the sport of competitive swimming.

Each week will focus on a different aspect of competitive swimming with attention to individual stroke technique, kick, form, and endurance.

### Swimming Pool/Spa Operators Certification Course

Designed to teach basic fundamentals of swimming pool/spa operations. Topics will include basic water chemistry, filtration, circulation, safety, and risk management of aquatic facilities. This course meets the requirements for the State of Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene Swimming Pool and Spa Operator Certification. Participants are required to pass a written exam to be eligible for certification. Participants must be 16 years or older and are required to attend all classes. No refunds will be given to those who do not pass the certification exam.

## Lifeguard Training

### Lifeguard Prep Class

Class will focus on swimming endurance and necessary skills needed to meet prerequisites of upcoming Lifeguard classes.

### Lifeguard Class

This course is designed to provide lifeguards with the knowledge and skills necessary to ensure the safety of patrons at aquatic facilities. Both a written and practical exam will be given at the end of the course and American Red Cross certification cards will be issued to all students that successfully complete all components of the class. Participants are required to attend all classes. Refunds will not be given to those who do not pass the prerequisite skills or the final written and/or practical exam.

#### Prerequisites

- Must be age 15 on or before last day of class (proof of age required).
- Swim 300 yards continuously using 100 yards front crawl, 100 yards breaststroke, 100 yards your choice of either front crawl, breaststroke.
- Breaststroke must be performed using a pull, breathe, kick, glide sequence.
- Able to retrieve a 10 pound object from 7-10 feet depth, return to the surface, swim 20 yards back to the starting point with object. Must be completed within the required 1:40 time limit.

## SCUBA Classes

### Discover SCUBA Diving

Interested in trying SCUBA before you take the certification class? By participating in a brief orientation and medical clearance under the guidance of dive instructors and dive masters, you get the opportunity to try SCUBA in a comfortable, controlled environment. Children age 13-18 must have parent accompany and sign required forms at orientation session. No equipment necessary.

### SCUBA Diving

Class offers SCUBA diving certification through the PADI Open Water Diver Course. Course is led by a certified dive instructor and includes classroom sessions and practice dive sessions in the pool. Upon completion of academic and pool trainings, you have one year to complete your open water training dives (\*not included in fees), to complete certification. Included in course fees are manual with DVD, diving equipment, instructor and pool fees. Participants must attend orientation session, complete minimum swimming and medical requirements to purchase mask, fins, and snorkel prior to the first pool session. Children 13-18 must have parent accompany and sign required forms at orientation session.

## Swim Lessons

**Resident Fee: \$55 • Non-Resident: \$60**

Sessions consist of eight, 35-minute classes. Each session includes one day of basic water safety skills. Children should be able to perform all skills of the previous level before moving on to a higher level. For safety reasons, all class sizes are limited to a maximum number of participants. Classes may be canceled due to low enrollment. Instructors may move children to a different level class if the child is unable to participate in the skill level of the registered class. Please contact the Aquatics Supervisor if health conditions warrant additional accommodations for participation. Registration is on a first-come, first-serve basis.

### Infant/Toddler • Age 6-36 mos

Requirements: Parent or guardian to accompany child in water. Skills: Designed to teach parents the skills and techniques to encourage and develop a comfort level for young children in and around water. Classes include guided instructional teaching, as well as individual parent and child water exploration.

### Preschool 1 • Age 3-5

Skills: Designed to orient young children to water safety and provide an introduction to basic swimming skills. Includes submerging, floating, kicking, bobbing, using arms on both stomach and back.

### Preschool 2 • Age 3-5

Requirements: Must have successfully completed Preschool 1 skills. Must be able to fully submerge head, and be comfortable with the water. Skills: Course works on floating, and introduces combined stroke (arms/legs) on both stomach and back.

### Preschool 3 • Age 3-5

Requirements: Must have successfully completed Preschool 2 skills. Must be comfortable with underwater swimming, able to float unsupported, and swim 5 yds on stomach and back by themselves. Skills: Continues with combined stroke on stomach and back, introduction of elementary back stroke, deep water skills.

### Level 1

Requirements: Designed for non-swimmers. Course is an introduction to water safety and basic swimming skills. Includes submerging, floating, kicking, bobbing, alternate arm action.

### Level 2

Requirements: Must have successfully completed Level 1 skills. Must be able to fully submerge head and be comfortable with the water. Skills: Course works on floating, and introduces combined stroke (arms/legs) on both stomach and back.

### Level 3

Requirements: Must have successfully completed Level 2 skills or Preschool 3. Must be comfortable with underwater swimming, able to float, and swim 15 yds on stomach and back. Skills: class builds on acquired combined stroke on stomach and back. Adds deep water skills, elementary backstroke, and beginner diving.

### Level 4

Requirements: Must have successfully completed Level 3 skills. Must be able to swim 25 yds (one length of pool) front crawl, and back crawl. Skills: Refine technique of previous skills. Front and back crawl, elementary backstroke, breaststroke and sidestroke emphasized. Also improves diving from standing position.

### Level 5

Requirements: Must have successfully completed Level 4 skills. Must be able to swim 50 yds (2 pool lengths) of front and back crawl. Must be able to correctly demonstrate elementary backstroke, breaststroke, and sidestroke. Skills: Class builds on skills from previous levels and refines strokes of front crawl, backstroke, breaststroke, sidestroke, and diving. Also learn basic butterfly stroke.

### Adult Beginner • Age 16+

Requirements: For non-swimmers. Skills: Gain confidence in and around water. Focus on submerging, floating, kicking, bobbing, and alternate arm action, and putting it together with combined stroke.

### Adult Advanced • Age 16+

Requirements: Must be able to fully submerge head, float, and be comfortable in water. Skills: Course teaches combined stroke (arms/legs) on both stomach and back. Class builds on acquired skills and adds deep water skills, elementary backstroke kick, and treading water.

Respect the school and its facilities; without them you wouldn't have a place to play.

### Parents & Spectators

Display good sportsmanship. Always respect players, coaches, and officials.

Know and study the rules of the game and support the officials.

Act appropriately; do not taunt or disturb other fans. Enjoy the game.

Cheer in a positive manner and encourage fair play.

Do not embarrass children by yelling, booing, or criticizing. Be supportive.

Do not use foul language.

Applaud a good effort in victory or defeat.

Recognize the importance of volunteer coaches.

Approved refunds will be assessed a \$10 administrative fee per child, per session regardless of circumstances.


