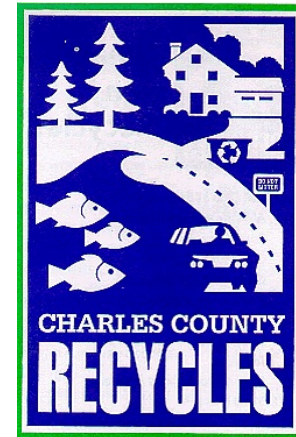

Within this directory, you will find various items willingly accepted by local organizations. Merely locate the type of item that you are interested in donating and then match the number(s) listed next to it with the coinciding number of the organization(s). We advise you to call them first to ensure continued acceptance of your type of item.

Before throwing anything away, always think: Reduce! The greatest relief against the solid waste burden is to avoid it in the first place. The less we purchase, the less waste we will have. Buying in bulk with less packaging, sharing, or renting items are excellent ways to reduce. Using “previously-owned” items from yard sales, thrift shops, etc. is also an option.

Reuse! Give unwanted clothes, furniture, toys, etc., to family, friends, or your church. Or, of course, you can always donate useable items to places such as those listed here.

Recycle! Old cans become new cans, plastic bottles can be turned into plastic furniture, playgrounds can be made out of scrap tires! These are just a few examples of what recycling can accomplish. It also takes less energy and conserves earth’s natural resources!
